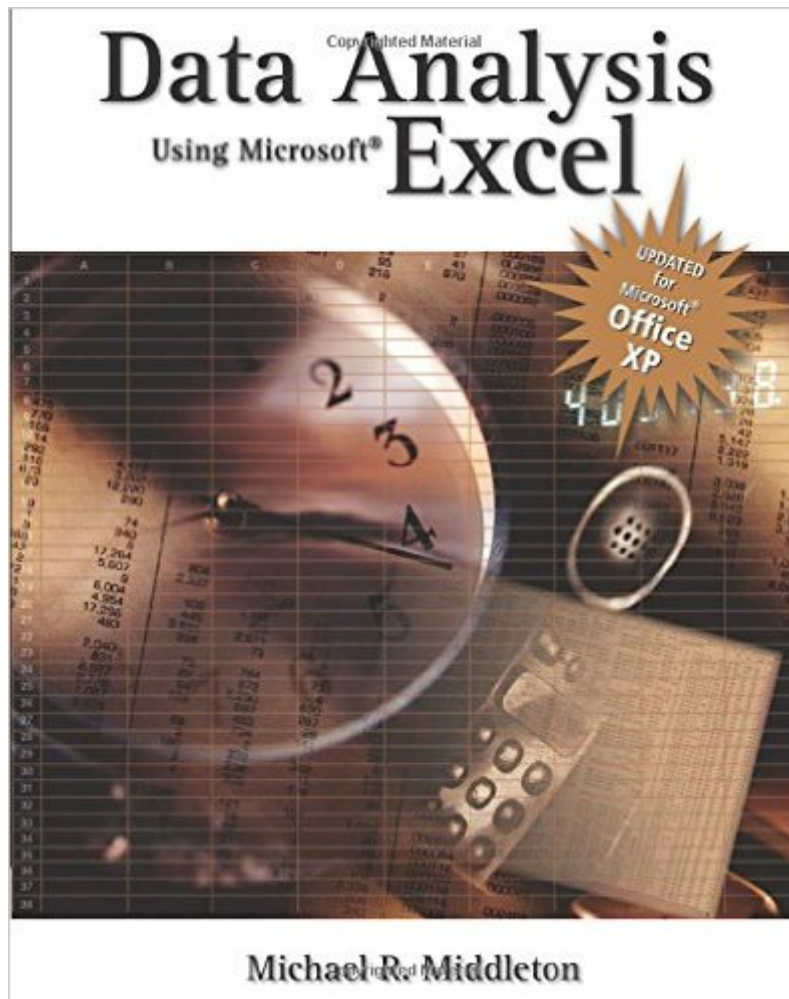

The book is a good fundamentals review of Excel capability for statistical data analysis. This type of book is good to have as a reference for those not using Excel stats every day. Simple, and clear how to do it which I like. Dr. Middleton's style is simple and straightforward as noted in other software and publications which is great for those of us who are not statisticians but need statistics to help convey risk, variability and analysis conclusions.
